1. <u>Purpose.</u> This Directive transmits a revised page for the July 2016 edition of the

Governor's Statewide Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)

Fiscal Procedures Manual.

2. <u>Discussion.</u> Effective January 1, 2022, the mileage rate paid to persons traveling in

privately owned vehicles on official business for the state increased to 58.5 cents per mile. Subsequently, the mileage rate paid to persons traveling in privately owned vehicles on official business for the state increased to 62.5 cents per mile effective July 1, 2022. The rate of 58.5 cents per mile is in effect for reimbursement of travel during the months of January 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022. The rate of 62.5 cents per mile is in effect for reimbursement of travel from July 1, 2020 through the end of the year. A copy of the State Comptroller's announcements are attached for reference. This change necessitates a revision to the *Statewide WIOA Fiscal Procedures*

Subject: Travel Mileage Rate for 2022

Effective January 1, 2022, the mileage rate paid to persons traveling in privately owned vehicles on official business for the State will increase to 58.5 cents per mile. The mileage rate, which is paid in lieu of actual expenses for transportation, is in accordance with <u>Code of Alabama 1975</u>, 36-7-22, as amended, which became effective October 1, 1999. This code section sets the mileage rate at the amount allowed by the Internal Revenue Code for income tax deductions. Therefore, mileage reimbursement for travel on or after January 1, 2022, will be calculated at the new rate of 58.5 cents per mile.

When calculating the amount reimbursed, all mileage listed on an expense account must be totaled and then multiplied by 58.5 cents (Example: 111 miles x .585 = \$64.94). SUBJECT: Updated Travel Mileage Rate for 2022

Effective July 1, 2022, the mileage rate paid to persons traveling in privately owned vehicles on official business for the State will increase to 62.5 cents per mile. The mileage rate, which is paid in lieu of actual expenses for transportation, is in accordance with Code of Alabama 1975, 36-7-22, as amended, which became effective October 1, 1999. This code section sets the mileage rate at the amount allowed by the Internal Revenue Code for income tax deductions. Therefore, mileage reimbursement for travel on or after July 1, 2022, will be calculated at the new rate of 62.5 cents per mile.

When calculating the amount reimbursed, all mileage listed on an expense account must be totaled and then multiplied by 62.5 cents (Example: 111 miles x .625 = \$69.38). Any mileage prior to July 1, 2022, should be on a separate travel statement for this reason.
