

Statewide WIOA Annual Performance For PY20



- 10,403 WIOA participants were served in Alabama Career Centers during PY20
(This number does not include those served by Wagner-Peyser Staff)
- A total of 297 Veterans were served in Alabama Career Centers by WIOA staff during PY20 and provided a variety of in person supportive, career, and training services (This number does not include those served by Wagner-Peyser Staff)
- 7,216 Adult participants were served in Alabama Career Centers by WIOA staff during PY20 and received a variety of career, training, and supportive services
- 1,363 Dislocated Worker participants were served in Alabama Career Centers by WIOA staff during PY20 and received a variety of career, training, and supportive services
- 1,824 Youth participants were served in Alabama Career Centers by WIOA staff during PY20 and received a variety of career, training, and supportive services
- 1,242 Job Fairs were conducted by WIOA and Employment Service (ES) staff both onsite and offsite during PY20.
- Alabama's Career Center WIOA staff delivered 10,880 services to employers during PY20, including providing information, training, and supportive services
- 19 Incumbent Worker Training Program (IWTP) projects were conducted through the State of Alabama during PY20 using WIOA funds
- 145 Alabama workers received training and upskilling through Incumbent Worker Training Program (IWTP) projects during PY20
- 42 Rapid Response meetings were conducted in Alabama Due to Layoffs and Closures during PY20
- The Alabama Department of Commerce and the Alabama Department of Labor completed the process of transitioning to a unified data system (AlabamaWorks!) during PY 2020
