The purpose of this memo is to clarify the Governor's Local Workforce Area Youth Provider staff time allocation policy. In order to be reimbursed each month, providers must submit timesheets to document their staff's regular work hours to the Workforce Development Division's Accounting Section. Documentation of the hours worked by Youth Provider staff is required with the monthly invoice.

The original memo caused confusion instructing Providers that the requirement to allocate and document their staff's time between Program or Work-Based Learning funding was no longer required as of July 1, 2022.
