Local Area Designation Policy

1. Purpose.

To transmit a revision to the State's Local Area Designation Policy to include information regarding the reallocation of unobligated and unspent Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) carryover funds when there are changes to the configuration of the local workforce development areas.

2. Discussion.

When there are re-designations of established local workforce development areas (LWDAs), all unobligated and unspent funds will be reallocated by the State WIOA Office with the exception of any previously awarded Incentive funds, which may be retained by administrative entities that are also administrative entities under the newly configured LWDAs. Note that all other WIOA formula-allocated Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker carryover funds will be reallocated to the LWDAs, which comprise the newly designated total configuration of the State. The allocation formula (that will be used) is the formula for the most recent allocation of WIOA funds from the U.S. Department of Labor.

3. Action.

This policy should be utilized for carryover WIOA funds reallocations when the reallocations are due to changes in the configuration of the LWDAs within the State.
